



About Fredriksborg

Fredriksborg Fortress was built to protect Stockholm at "Oxdjupet", the only deep entrance. In 1735, this was among Europe's strongest fortresses and it protected the inlet for about 100 years. The hotel buildings, old officers' residences from the same time, were in 2011-2015 converted into hotels by SFV. The hotel got 15 rooms, period details have been preserved and adaptation has been made for modern hotel operations. It is classified as a state memorial building.

The hotel is built on a plateau some 30 meters up. The tower of the fortress reaches 60 meters. Fredriksborg is ca 40 minutes by car, bus or RIB boat from Stockholm. The kitchen is of a high standard and Fredriksborg Hotel has achieved high guest ratings on e.g. Booking.com.

Open all year round for pre-booked private and corporate events, as well as regularly for private guests on weekends, summer time and Christmas. If necessary, all or parts of Fredriksborg can be rented with exclusivity for e.g. conference, courses, events, Christmas parties, weddings, filming, photography, private parties, etc. The hotel can stay open until 03:00 by agreement.

Details

Fredriksborg consists of approx. 46,000 square meters of natural and garden land and buildings;

The stone barracks from 1751 is the main building and hotel with 10 rooms, conference room, dining room and lounge. The conference room accommodates 35 in cinema seating and 16 in board seating, or 30 guests as a dining room. The dining room can accommodate 20 diners. The lounge can accommodate approx. 15 people on sofas etc. Bars are in the reception or the orangery.

The officer's residence from 1724 has 5 rooms with direct entrance and surrounding terrace.

The entire hotel has 15 double rooms, 10 of which have separable beds. 33 beds incl. extra beds. 12 rooms have WC/shower, 3 rooms have WC/bathtub. 12 rooms have a sea view. 5 rooms have a terrace. 2 attic rooms, 1 suite, 4 small and 6 ordinary double, 2 Panorama rooms. All have TV / WiFi.

The orangery is modern, 66 sqm, ca 44 diners and has heating, fireplace, bar and sound system.

The outdoor terrace south of the Stone Barracks has ca 100 seats but can be expanded. South facing.

The event/wedding tent north of the Stone Barracks is 150 sqm and can hold up to 140 people.

Fredriksborg fortress has a cannon floor of approx. 600 sqm, 7 m ceiling height, good acoustics, 3-phase electricity and bar/fridge. Holds 150 people. It can be used for music, exhibitions, events etc.

The observation tower on the roof holds 15 people.

The Caponier (cannon tower) has three levels, the upper of which has approx. 90 sqm and 5m in ceiling height. Depending on the number of participants, adaptation is required before use.

The Corps de Garde pier has a kitchen and 3-phase electricity. The pier of about 500 sqm can accommodate ca 100 seated or 200 standing guests. Stone stairs down to Oxdjupet where ships can dock.

There is a small guest harbour with buoys for ca 6-7 leisure boats. No charge. First come, first served
